Our academic program, designed to maintain continuity with clients' home schools, is recognized by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) as a supplemental education program. Each of our residences has been designed to provide a comfortable and welcoming home-away-from-home. Our guiding philosophy emphasizes kindness and compassion over confrontation and control.

- 17 treatment campuses in Northern, Central, and Southern California, specializing in the treatment of primary mental health, substance use, and dual-diagnosis in adolescents, ages 12-17
- Robust family programming with multiple weekly support sessions, check-ins, multi-family support groups, and 4 months of no-cost alumni family support
- Certified by California DHCS for residential detox (NorCal only) and residential treatment, and licensed by California DSS
- Gender-separate treatment programs accredited by The Joint Commission






Muir Wood uses outcome measurement tools that meet or exceed Joint Commission standards to ensure that our treatment produces positive health outcomes for clients and achieves a high level of parent and guardian satisfaction with the Muir Wood treatment experience. These outcome measures use 2019 – 2021 Muir Wood client data collected and analyzed by Trac9 Informatics, a behavioral healthcare outcome measurement company whose mission "is to provide gold-standard assessments and custom predictive analytics to improve the efficacy of treatment."


Trac 9 assists with Joint Commission accreditation requirements under standard CTS.03.01.09 and CARF accreditation requirements under the 2018 Behavioral Health Standards – Section M.2, M.4-5. In addition, family satisfaction information uses data supplied by Muir Wood client parent and guardian post-treatment surveys. Overall Treatment Effectiveness Clientreported data collected by Trac9, an independent outcome measurement provider, shows that Muir Wood Adolescent and Family Services treatment results in better treatment outcomes measures compared to the national average of treatment providers. These outcome data represent reporting following four weeks of treatment at Muir Wood












Muir Wood Clients are less depressed than the national average
